NATIONAL SOKOL SUMMER CAMP 2009
RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

IN CONSIDERATION of being given the opportunity to participate in any NATIONAL SOKOL SUMMER CAMP ("CAMP") activities from August 2 to August 9, 2009, I, for myself, my personal representatives, assigns, heirs, and next of kin:

1. ACKNOWLEDGE, AGREE AND REPRESENT that I understand the nature of camping activities, including swimming, rafting, hiking, artistic gymnastics, team sports and other games, both water and land based ("CAMPING ACTIVITIES") and that I am qualified, in good health and in proper physical condition to participate in such activities;
2. FULLY UNDERSTAND THAT: A)CAMPING ACTIVITIES INVOLVE RISKS AND DANGERS of serious bodily injury, including permanent disability, paralysis and death ("RISKS"); B) these RISKS and dangers may be caused by my own actions or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating in the CAMPING ACTIVITIES, the conditions in which the CAMPING ACTIVITIES take place, or the negligence of the RELEASEES named below; C) there may be other RISKS and social and economic losses either not known to me or not readily foreseeable at this time; and I FULLY ACCEPT AND ASSUME SUCH RISKS AND ALL RESPONSIBILITY FOR LOSSES, COSTS, AND DAMAGES I incur as a result of my participation in the CAMPING ACTIVITIES;
3. AGREE AND WARRANT that I examine and inspect each CAMPING ACTIVITY in which I take part as a camper at the NATIONAL SOKOL SUMMER CAMP and that, if I observe any condition which I consider to be unacceptably hazardous or dangerous, I will notify the proper authority in charge of the CAMPING ACTIVITY and will refuse to take part in the CAMPING ACTIVITY until the condition has been corrected to my satisfaction;
4. HEREBY RELEASE, DISCHARGE AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE American Sokol, Delnicky Americky Sokol (D.A. Sokol), Sokol USA, Sokol Greater Cleveland, or DTJ Camp, their administrators, directors, agents, officers, volunteers and employees, other participants, and if applicable, owners or lessors of the premises on which the CAMPING ACTIVITIES take place, (each considered one of the RELEASEES herein) from all liability, claims, demands, losses or damages on my account, caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the negligence of the RELEASEES or otherwise, and I further agree that if, despite this RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK, AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT, I, or anyone on my behalf makes a claim against any of the RELEASEES, I WILL INDEMNIFY, SAVE, AND HOLD HARMLESS each of the RELEASEES from any litigation's expenses, attorney fees, loss, liability, damage, or cost which any may incur as a result of such claim.
