



TAG TEAM COMPETITION

Senior competitors ONLY. Sorry, no Juniors or younger.

No one "tag team" member can do more than 2 events.

Teams may be comprised as follows:

- MEN** - All 6 events must be covered by either 3, 4, 5, or 6 competitors.
- With 3 "tag team" members, each gymnast performs 2 events.
 - With 4 "tag team" members, two gymnasts each perform 2 events and 2 gymnasts each perform 1 event.
 - With 5 "tag team" members, 4 gymnasts each perform 1 event and 1 gymnast performs 2 events..
 - With 6 "tag team" members, each gymnast performs 1 event.
- WOMEN** - All 4 events must be covered by either 2, 3, or 4 competitors.
- With 2 "tag team" members, each gymnast performs 2 events.
 - With 3 "tag team" members, 1 gymnast performs 2 events and 2 gymnasts each perform 1 event.
 - With 4 "tag team" members, each gymnast performs 1 event.

The teams may be comprised of individuals in any Adult Age Group or Competitive Level. Each competitor shall compete their particular event(s) in one level only. For example: A competitor cannot compete in a Level 2 Beam routine and also in a Level 4 Floor routine. Teams, however, may be made up of gymnasts from different levels. For instance, a team may consist of one gymnast doing Level 4 Beam and Floor and the other gymnast doing Level 2 Vault and Uneven Bars.

Each team member's individual event score(s) will be tabulated into the "Tag Team" score.

Any one individual event score can only be applied to one team score. An example: A member of a Level 6 team of men may not participate in the "Tag Team" competition because his score will be tallied into his Level 6 team score.

Individual all-around competitors may have 1 or 2 of their event scores applied to a "Tag Team" score as long as the individual is not part of another team.

The "Tag Team" competition will occur concurrently with the regular competition. Scores will be tabulated separately.

The "Tag Team" may be from a single unit or any combination of units within the same district, but must be entered in accordance with the scheduled entry due date.
