YOUTH MEMBERSHIP:

NEW UNIFORM PROJECT

- Sis. M. Fiordelis reported the committee is continuing to look at designs and color schemes. There will be some samples at the convention for the directors to look at and provide feedback. The design will be simpler.

2010 NATIONAL INSTRUCTORS SCHOOL

- Sis. Wise sent everything out. The logos for the shirt are being worked out.
- Sis. Wise needs to get in touch with Sis. M. Tooke about the credit card.

2010 NATIONAL SOKOL CAMP

- The camp staff held a face-to-face meeting. The entire week was planned and they now need to develop those activities. Sis. L. Laznovsky will be in town tomorrow and she will meet with Bro. Pajer for more discussions.
- Still promoting the deals and specials in order to get more youth to attend. Bro. Pajer encouraged all directors to push to get kids to come to camp. Central District put together an '80s night for juniors with camp and course materials available.
- There is a flyer in the Director's Newsletter about the savings. This is the 10th anniversary of the camp and will be something special.

OTHER OLD AND NEW BUSINESS:

ASO National Convention

- District Directors and BOI leadership met last week. For the upcoming four years, the National BOI is going to be operated with a slightly different structure. There will be only one National Director and there will be assistants on both the men's side and the women's side to assist the one Director. The BOI Leadership and the District Directors from all the districts except the Pacific District (no contact) unanimously approved this plan. Only one Director will be elected at the Convention.
- A packet with Bylaw changes referred to ASO BOI has been sent to those who are convention delegates for the BOI or for their unit. There were a number of items which were referred back to committees or groups for additional information or reconsideration from the bylaws committee. Several were referred back to the BOI. One item referred back to the BOI was the recommendation that the District BOI go to one director structure and to include that possibility in the bylaws; there is no reason for this to be the case in the Districts and Units. Another recommendation was that the Education Director or duly appointed representative be included in the BOI Annual Conference and their travel and expense be defrayed, which should come out of the education budget. The National Education Director is a member of the BOI according to the bylaws. After discussion, the BOI decided to send this recommendation to the Education Director so this item would come out of the education budget.

MOTION made by Sis. J. Kalat to send this recommendation back to the Bylaws Committee to send back to the Educational Committee to put the cost into the educational budget and that the National Education Director be present at the monthly BOI meetings, seconded by Sis. M. Fiordelis and passed.

- Discussed officer transition timeline. It was questioned when new officers take over. Typically, the executive board transitions the meeting after the convention. Both the old and new executive boards attend that meeting for transition. Historically, the Directors have continued in office through June because of activities going on.

MOTION made by Bro. T. Pajer that the new BOI officers should take over at the same time as the new executive board, which is expected to be the first month after the convention, but no later than July 1, seconded by Sis. B. Kucera and passed.

- Sis. B. Kucera noted that the new Director needs to appoint a Merit Award Committee prior to June 1. It would be up to the new Director to ask the current committee to retain their job without actually appointing a new committee.

<u>Compatriot Festival – Prague, September 2010</u>

- Festival is being held in Prague in early September. This festival is mostly for folk groups, i.e dancers and singers, who are keeping the folk history and activities alive in whatever country they live in. The BOI does not usually pursue this type of activity. Bro. Kalat will contact units that are involved with folk arts and see if they are interested. Other than that, there will be no National BOI involvement.

MOTION made by Sis. J. Kalat that this issue has been discussed by the BOI and the National BOI will have no participation, but the information will be forwarded to units that do participate in these activities, seconded by Sis. B. Kucera and passed.

Camp/School Promotion Video and Mailing

- Thanks to Sis. Jane and Bro. Howie Wise, Bro. Kevin Fitzpatrick, Lori Laznovsky/Tom Pajer, and Lynette Gilbert who accomplished this task. Thanks to Sis. J. LoGiudice for mailing it out. Central District pitched these events at their '80s night by showing the video.

2010 WSF Fitness Testing Program

- Sis. J. Wise is hoping that those who are participating will meet the April 1st deadline. Sis. Wise will deliver most of the stuff at convention rather than mail. Sokol USA will subsidize use of the ASO administration of this program with \$2 per participant.

WSF Show Program

- Central District's Special Number Competition is after the deadline for submitting numbers. Bro. C. Kalat contacted the WSF Directors and they indicated they will gladly accept our entries up to April 25, 2010.
- Sokol Greater Cleveland indicated they may have some entries that they will send directly to Bro. Pajer to include on DVD.

Strategic Planning Committee Progress Report

- Sis. M. Fiordelis gave a brief summary of the SPTF teams.
- The Organizational Development Team continues to meet on a weekly basis to prepare for the convention.
- The Finance Committee is putting the final touches on their Resource Guide and is expected at any time.
- The Leadership Development Team is starting next Monday.
- The Communication and Marketing Team will also be starting soon.
- The SPTF will be making multiple presentations at the convention with the Implementation Team talking about its successes and programs and a progress report from the Organizational Development Team.

<u>Other</u>

- Sis. M. Fiordelis asked about any clarification on the Western District Instructor School. Sis. Gerber said the information went out to the Western District unit directors only and it is a district function. The Western District course begins June 20, 2010.
- Sis. L. Laznovsky sent out information on the Portugal Over-50 Gym Fest.
