2013 Sports Festival

Update

- Sis. Fiordelis is testing registration system. Announcement will be sent out on how to access from ASO web site.
- The Sports Festival pricing information was posted in the Directors Newsletter.
- Currently, working on daily and weekly spectator passes to cover different events. There will be individual/family and coach passes.

#### Survey

- Bro. and Sis. Kalat put the survey information together. There were 23 surveys received. Sokol Ferrell and Sokol Ft. Worth had no data entered on their surveys. There are 15 surveys missing. None have yet been received from Sokols New York, Detroit, Crete, Omaha and Chicago Lodge 306 amongst others.
- Artistic gymnastics: Girls 77; Junior Girls 66; Women 56; Boys 29; Junior Boys 19; Men 25; for a total of 272 gymnastic competitors.
- Rhythmic gymnastics: Girls 2; Junior Girls 2; Women 16; for a total of 20 rhythmic competitors.
- Other Rhythmic: 2 group rhythmic; 11 rhythmic skills; no festival rhythmic.
- Team Marching 15; Team Cal 8; Volleyball 21; Basketball 7; Fitness Challenge 243; Wheels 3.
- Fun Run: Youth 83; Adults 15; for a total of 98.
- 5K Run 46; Golf 30; Bowling 78; Kick-off Social 252; Youth Activity 182; Ice Skating Social 179; Finale Social 322; Banquet 106; Food Tour 126; Brewers Game 176; Brewery Tour 102.
- Closing Ceremony Program: Tots Cal 17; Children's Cal 90; Junior Cal 116; Adult Cal 142; Senior II Cal 75; Folk Dance 4 couples and 3 individuals; Hand Jive Special Number 295.
- Sis. Fiordelis may hear back yet with numbers from USAG Festival Rhythmic and Special Olympics Rhythmic competitors.
- Any events that do not have enough participants for the Sports Festival will be canceled.

#### FAQs (Frequently Asked Questions)

- Frequently asked questions section will be included in the next Festival Bulletin. This should answer questions from several e-mails that have been received.
- Survey numbers and actual numbers aren't always the same. Directors should be pushing the Sports Festival to their units and membership so that the Sports Festival will have a large contingent.
- Surveys were sent to outside groups. We have not heard back from anyone. We will need to push harder to hear from them.
- Information about the planned socials will be in the next Bulletin.
- The Brewery Tour is open to families; no tasting for minors.

#### National Summer Camp

- Camp will be held in Detroit, MI. The selected dates are August 10-17, 2013; however, some school districts will be starting school sports that week. Sis. Fiordelis will see if there is a late July week available instead.
- Detroit's President and Chairman of the Unit Property Committee discussed the details.
- Tents will be used for sleeping.
- Kevin Fitzpatrick is gathering counselors and staff and will be putting together a flier and information for the next Directors' Newsletter.

#### National Weekend Instructors School

- District and Unit Directors were encouraged to have their district or units hold a school.
