Skills Month

- Discussion followed concerning moving the Winter Slet to another location. It was also noted that the original intention was not to do the Winter Slet every year; possibly skip the year after Slet.

2010 National Instructors School

- Sis. J. Wise reported that a collection of staff members met the first week of December. They were updating their guideline books. Those that were in attendance were Mary Cushing, Steve Wise, Kevin Fitzpatrick, Sonia Nakonecznyj, Heidi Vencl and Gretchen Obrovec. They met Friday night, Saturday until 6:00 p.m. and Sunday until noon. Peter Lattanzio called in on a conference call for part of that time. Sis. Cushing had them divided into the areas that they teach and they had time to work together and write different information for the guideline book. Sis. M. Cushing would have more information about this meeting.

National Camp

- Plan on dedicating the nights of June 10 and 11, 2010 for reviewing the videos so our results can be submitted on June 12, 2010. Each organization will choose its 7 favorites.
