



## QUESTIONS, ANSWERS & Info... March 2018

### Information:

- Day & Half-Day Tours: Schedule and Registration form is on the website – Deadline: **April 1<sup>st</sup>**.
- Bus Seats to the Slet Performances: Each seat must be paid for – even if you have children. Buses take a head count, so each seat is \$35.
- Deposits/Payments: 2<sup>nd</sup> Deposits were due Feb. 1<sup>st</sup>. Invoices for Pre, Post Tours and Hotels will be sent out this week. **Final Payments due April 15<sup>th</sup>**.
- Bus Seats: Deadline April 1<sup>st</sup> with Payment.
- Slet Ticket Package: Everyone needs the ticket package if you are participating and/or going to the events and want free public transportation.
- Children 0-6 are free on Public Transportation
- Senior Citizens are free on Public Transportation
- You always need some change (10-25 Czech Crowns in case there is a charge for a bathroom).

### Frequently Asked Questions:

Q: If I registered for Day tours on the first form do I need to do it again?

A: YES, please re-register to confirm and submit payment.

Q: What do I wear for the Parade?

A: American Sokol Parade Uniform is standard. You are allowed to wear the official dress uniform or the official gym/cal uniform. Please contact your Unit or the National office if you need more information. Final order for gym uniforms is April 1<sup>st</sup>.

Q: Money: How should I plan to bring money.

A: You can get Czech Crowns at a bank before you leave, use an ATM in Czech Republic or exchange money at a money exchange when you get there. I personally bring a limited amount of US cash, and just use a respected ATM. It all depends on your own bank's rates.

Q: Where will I pick up my Ticket Package or Cal Uniform?

A: We will assign a specific hotel or room at the Czech Sokol to pick these up. If someone is picking everything up for you, please send us an email giving permission. Main pick up day will be June 30th. Special arrangements need to be made if you are arriving on the 29<sup>th</sup> and would like your tickets then. Q: How will we get from the Airport to the hotel when we arrive in Prague?

A: We will post information on the website to guide you. Taxi information or local bus.

Q: How will we get from the hotels to the Airport?

A: If there is interest we can order a bus to depart early morning on the 7<sup>th</sup> and then again at noon. This will depend on the need and interest from our travelers. Please contact us if there is interest. The cost will be distributed between those committing to the transport.

Q: Cellphones?

A: Please check with your carrier to determine how you will use your phone in the Czech Republic. There is wifi everywhere and now free roaming in the Czech Republic. You can make wifi phone calls on iPhones, Facebook and other apps like WhatsApp and Viber.
