Sokol Greater Cleveland Celebrates in 2022

In December of 2021 Sokol Greater Cleveland (SGC) was honored by American Nationalities Movement, an organization founded by past Mayor of Cleveland of Czech descent Ralph Perk, for the unit’s service to the community. This is the first time an organization was chosen; typically it is individuals such as Ohio Secretary of State, one of the other honorees this year. The year 2022 will be an exciting year for SGC as the building the organization owns and is based in will celebrate 125 years since the dedication. A variety of celebratory events are planned culminating in a gala on September 25th – the building know as the Bohemian National Hall was dedicated on September 26th, 1897. One of the first events will take place on Saturday, January 22 at 7:30pm (EST). This Virtual SGC Auction will feature Czech crystal, Czech garnet jewelry, paintings of Prague, and more. Sokols from around the country are welcome to join via zoom. A short video tour of our building will be part of the event, come and join the camaraderie from around the nation. **AMERICAN SOKOL
2021 DISTRICT DIRECTORS’ CONFERENCE**

The American Sokol District Directors’ conference was held on Saturday, October 9, 2021 at the Hyatt House Chicago in Oak Brook. Five districts of the American Sokol BOI were represented at the conference. Also in attendance were the ASO President, National Physical Directors, Assistants, Recording Secretary, School Board Director, Board Members, and National Membership Director.

At the conference each district gave updates about how their districts were handling the re-opening of their gyms and following Covid safety precautions. Each district submitted an annual report which will be posted on the American Sokol website. We had representation from Sokol USA and were presented a report which detailed information about their lodges. There are no definite plans for Sokolfest 2023 at this time due to Covid.

The School Board gave a report through a PowerPoint presentation detailing 1) Pros and cons of the 2021 Virtual School and 2) The bids received from units to host the 2022 Instructor School 3) 2022 School Budget 4) School Board goals and 5) Standing Operating Procedures.

As a National BOI we discussed the upcoming convention to be held in 2022 in Texas. The BOI is proposing adding a bylaw to accept the youth director under the ASO BOI under Article 12. We also reviewed and discussed other proposed changes to the by-laws that may be voted on at convention. The BOI also reviewed and updated their budget to be presented to the Budget and Finance committee.

The ASO BOI announced that Sis. Mary Cushing is interested in being the next National Physical Director. Her election will be ratified at the convention.

Report of Straz Honor Guard

Let me take this opportunity to thank American Sokol for the support of these historic events American Sokol Straz took part in. Thank you to Sisters Lynda Filipello, Allison Gerber, and Jean Hruby for the guidance and for being pillars of help in A.S. O. Straz. The Honor Guard has presided over many important events including the President of the Czech Republic, General from the Czech Military, and many Heads of State of the Foreign Ministry.

The A.S.O. Honor Guard Straz made history this past October 9, 2021 as we were the first non-Czech Citizens / Military to perform at the Prague Castle.

Training began each day at 8 A.M. ending at 5:30 or 7 P.M. We marched an average of 15 miles a day with drills including marching, Czech drill calls, wreath placing, flowers, flags and swords.

Ceremonies we participated in were Lidice, Church of Ss. Cyril, Czech TV interview, Tyrs Dum flag ceremony for official October 8th, candle lighting event at the bridge, and Prague Castle.

Announcing the American Sokol 2022 National Merit Award

The American Sokol Merit Award has been offered to members and/or the youth of members since 1975 and is funded by the American Sokol Leaders Fund. This award is administered by the National Educational Committee and the committee will be accepting applications for the 2022 Merit Awards as of January 1, 2022.

Eligible students are those who are planning or continuing a full time (at least 12 hours per semester or equivalent) course program in an accredited two-year or four-year college/university or trade school. The amount to be awarded is \$1,000.00 per student. There are no merit award renewals. Applicants may apply for any year of their studies, not just freshman year.

The selections are made by the American Sokol Educational Committee and then approved by the American Sokol Executive Board. The committee will consider the following criteria in selecting the candidates for their recommendation to the Executive Board:

Cultural and Educational Activities: Ethnic schools and activities, dance, theater, presentations to Sokol classes or other groups on Sokol history, traditions, or other topics.

Unit participation: unit membership, volunteerism, and community events to promote your Sokol unit at the local level.

District and National Participation: district and national activity in clinics, Slets, competitions, courses, committees, or other activities to promote your Sokol district and American Sokol.

Board of Instructor or Program Participation at the unit level: gym or dance class participation, gym or dance class instructor or assistant, participation in clinics, Slets, or competitions, and camps.

Community and Extracurricular Activities: Scouts, Civic organizations, service projects, and volunteer work

Personal Essay

Overall Leadership/Letter of recommendation from either the Unit President, Unit Educational Director, Unit Physical Director, or Unit Dance Instructor.
